FROM PASTOR JORDAN'S DESK

Greetings Everyone,

It is my hope and prayer that you're all doing well. As I am sure most of you know, I am currently in the Residency process to become an ordained elder in the United Methodist Church.

I know some are new to our church, even our denomination, who may not understand the ordination process for clergy. I am in my third year of a three-year process to become a fully ordained elder in the United Methodist Church. As a provisional member, I am required to participate in a three-year residency program. Within this three-year program, there are assignments and projects that must be completed to qualify for ordination. We are required to attend a Residency Retreat each Fall and there are monthly meetings all residents are required to attend. In the Spring, each candidate or resident is interviewed by the Board of Ordained Ministry. The Board will review the assignments and projects submitted to determine the status of the candidate or resident.

My time in residency is like an apprenticeship that requires continued education for the apprentice to grow. The same is true for clergy. To continue to grow as a pastor, I am required to attend these monthly meetings and work on these projects as part of my continuing education by the Kentucky Annual Conference.

As I am entering my third, and hopefully, final year of Residency, there are requirements I need to fulfill as I prepare to go before the Board of Ordained Ministry. As I am working toward ordination, I need your help. Over the next several months, I will be working on different assignments, and projects. These assignments and projects need to be completed October 31st and January 8th . I would appreciate your prayers as I work on these assignments and projects as they will be under review in the early Spring.

As I work towards completing these requirements, I will have to make some changes to my everyday schedule. From now until January 8th, I would appreciate it if appointments to see me or have me come visit are made in advance. I want to ensure that I am fully present and able to focus on the person/situation.

This does not mean I will be unavailable or unreachable via my phone, text message, or email. It may take a few hours or even a couple of days to respond, but I will get back with you. If there is an emergency, please know that you do not need to schedule an appointment. If there is a situation that needs my attention or a personal crisis, please reach out to me. I want to continue to be a support to our congregation and community, but I can't do that if I am not informed.

I covet your prayers in the months ahead as I continue to work towards ordination.
